I am a landscape architect of more than 40 years' experience. Professionally, my award-winning practice advises local authorities (including ERYC) and companies on landscape, design and planning matters for major projects. I am well-versed in community engagement, co-design, effective committee work and report-writing.

My key interests are around the environment of the villages: I wrote NCPC's Biodiversity Action Plan (adopted this June) and am organising a Biodiversity Public Meeting at the Village Hall in October, to connect experts with locals to generate great ideas for our wildlife. I want to join the Parish Council to bring more fairness and unity to NCPC's meetings and activities, wherever possible. Many meetings have been divisive and, therefore, ineffective, for a long time. I would bring a calm and considered attitude to all NCPC business, as well as professional knowledge to issues of trees, landscape and planning. 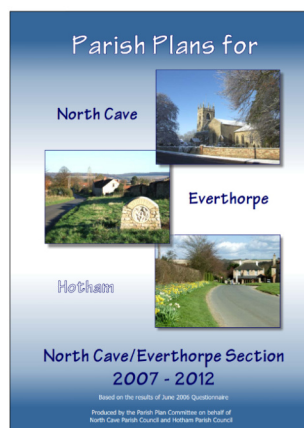
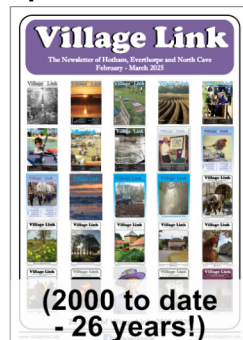
