



### Update - Spring 2023



Part of the Design Workshop looking at Drewton Beck, with representatives from Environment Agency, East Riding of Yorkshire Council, East Yorkshire Rivers Trust, Humber Forest and WWSTF. With thanks, for access to the land along the beck, to Christian Carver, Simon Gibson and ERYC.

During March, we held Design Workshops at:-

- Drewton Farm (west of the A1034) and Mill Farm Everthorpe (see pic above) which, together, make up a notable length of Drewton Beck. Followed by an indoor design session. tea and cake at William's Den :)
- Land above Millfield and at Woodale. Ellerker (with landowners, agencies and parish councillors) with a design session at Ellerker village hall
- The Mires and Pratt Wood at Newbald (with Trustees, Newbald Parish Councillors and agencies) with a design session at Newbald village hall.

Primary Schools. These planters 'slow the flow' of water from the school roofs, by intercepting the rain water down pipes into lined timber planters, which can hold a lot of water in their soil and gravel layers, before they overflow via a control point into the drain.

They are not going to make a huge difference to flooding in themselves, but they will teach the children, hands-on, that it is possible to manage water more sensibly than just getting rid of it, whilst also creating more beautiful and nature-friendly places.

In a small way, that is everything we want to achieve

These have been great sessions, very enjoyable and informative. Truth be told, it is not common for agencies, landowners and community to come together to work on flooding issues - and it's a revelation to see the ideas that come out of it.

Meanwhile, as you will see on the North Cave School page, we have been working with 'SusDrainable' to develop and install rain garden planters at North Cave and South Cave

### Litter in North Cave

In January Julie Steels and I decided to undertake the mammoth task of clearing the Village of its vast amount of litter. After many sessions, over six weeks, we reached the milestone of 100

bin bags full of rubbish as well as several piles of items which were too big to bag.

Now our big clearance is complete we will continue to collect litter during our regular walks as sadly this is an ongoing issue, we find that when we revisit the areas we have cleared there is more taking its place so we always have gloves and carrier bags in our pockets to pick up as we go.

One major issue we have in North Cave is discarded cigarette stubs which we pick up every day. Cigarette stubs are made of a type of plastic, they are not biodegradable and can take up to 14 years to break apart, the toxins can poison fish if they get in the water course, as well as animals who may eat them.



We know that a lot of the litter is thrown from vehicles passing through the village but there is much which has obviously been dropped whilst walking or deliberately dumped and



astonishingly there is a big issue with full dog poo bags being thrown into the hedges, the beck or just dropped in the verges. Such a shame that a few inconsiderate people spoil it for everyone else.

We would also like to thank Christian for his support with disposing of many of our filled bags and Alison and Gemma who joined us on a couple of our picks.

#### Greetings from North Cave Parish Council

We aim to hold our meetings on the 3rd Tuesday of every month at 7pm in the Village Hall. You are welcome to come to these meetings but please check the date before attending as sometimes we may have to move it for whatever reason. The minutes and agendas of each meeting are displayed in the notice board on the land adjacent to the Methodist Chapel on Westgate and also on the website:

Please note that the minutes of a meeting must be approved by the Parish Council before they are published so there will be some delay before they are made public.

We are due to hold an election this year for members of the Parish Council and are expecting several vacancies for parish councillors. If you would like to apply to sit on the parish council, please contact the Parish Clerk (details below). If there are more applicants than

vacancies, we will be required to hold an election. Otherwise the applicants will be co-opted without the need for an election. Please note that the role of councillor is a voluntary.

NOTE: From 4<sup>th</sup> May 2023, you will be required to show a valid form of photo ID before being allowed to vote in all local elections this year.

### **King Charles III**

The new king will be crowned on May 6th next year. If you have any ideas as to how we can celebrate or commemorate this occasion, please send them to the Parish Council Clerk.

### Tree planting

The Parish Council has received a grant for tree planting along Newport Road from ERYC. By the time you read this, the planting scheduled for March 16<sup>th</sup> should be completed. This will enhance the entrance to our village and be a "remembrance avenue" for our late queen and a celebration for our new king.

### **Millennium Walk**

Due to the recent episode of a tree falling down in Millennium Walk we have had a survey carried out by EYRC who have recommended that some trees need to be removed and additional pruning work carried out to avoid potential damage to property and for health and safety reasons. This work is due to be carried in April subject to planning permission being granted.

### **Dog walkers** - it's time to help North Cave Playing Fields!



### Message from the Church Wardens

The snowdrops in the old part of the churchyard have been better than ever, if you missed them this year don't forget to look next spring. The snowdrops are followed by the primulas unfortunately becoming strangled by the ivy we will be organising a work party once the weather improves to tackle this. The flowers are a joy to behold and a credit to the village. However all churches have had a polite reminder from York about what we can and cannot have in the graveyards. These are as follows:

- All flowers need to be removed from wrappings (there is a green bin at the large gate). We
  can not allow plastic flowers although silk ones can be placed as long as they are removed
  when they fade;
- No food or drink on graves;
- No toys or memorabilia;
- Commemorative wreathes should be removed after an appropriate length of time.

These conditions apply to all parts of the churchyard. Please would all users respect these wishes and help to keep this a quiet and reflective space.

### North Cave In Bloom

Spring, so far, has been very chilly but the snowdrops, daffodils and crocus planted around the village have brought a very welcome burst of colour heralding the end of winter.

The wildflower bed at the junction of Blossoms Lane has many spring bulbs coming through and hopefully it will flourish with many wild flowers sown and planted in the last two years. Sadly, some residents are allowing their dogs to use it as a toilet so please show some respect and keep your dogs off this area which is for the benefit of everyone.

NCIB held their AGM in February at the White Hart for the first time. We were made very welcome and were able enjoy a drink whilst discussing ideas so future meetings will be held there.

We will be using red, white, and blue summer bedding plants again this year, this time to celebrate King Charles III Coronation year. These will include non-stop begonias, geraniums, and lobelia for the planters, under road signs and wall baskets purchased from our local Sand Lane Plant Centre.

NCIB have made requests to the Parish Council to plant 2 trees on Froscoles Green to commemorate the reign of Queen Elizabeth II and King Charles III, apparently more work needs to be done to replace drainage pipes there so we will have to wait until later in the year. The other place we would like to plant more trees is the grass area at the top of Manor Road, this request needs to be approved by ERYC so we are hoping this will be approved by Autumn.

We are also hoping to site a new planter to commemorate King Charles III Coronation year once a suitable place has been sourced.

We purchased a new strimmer last year which has been used on the wildflower verge on Station Road. The grass is a problem as it is choking the wildflowers there so we will buy some yellow rattle plants in the hope they supress some of the grass, allowing the flowers to bloom.

North Cave in Bloom are very grateful for all the help we receive from our team of volunteers who clear, plant, weed etc., not forgetting our helpers who water and help to maintain our plants for us.

Our April meeting will involve skill too, but this time it will be gin tasting!


