

Additionally, and because of a successful grant from the National Lottery Community Fund, the original wall running the length of the orchard, which had been taken down and replaced with an unsafe stretch of fence has been beautifully rebuilt by James, Sandra and Martin's son, restoring the wall to its former state.





Orlok, one of the forty-five artfully painted rats from the "Mischief of Rats" trail, in aid of Dove House Hospice, has left the orchard but he has had lots of visitors, some of whom used the orchard for a picnic and also collected fruit.

This fantastic total came from entry donations, t-shirt optouts, and the generosity




of individual supporters.

### AGMs - 13th October at 7pm

The Playing Field Association and the Social Club are holding their AGMs. If you would like to find out more - come along and ask or even offer help. You might feel that you don't have a lot of time to give but every little helps - maybe just for an event like the Gala Day, fund raising, or to lend a hand when needed.

### **Future Plans**

The playing fields play host to four football teams, two senior cricket and two junior cricket teams and are now extremely well used. Around 20 years ago, the playing surface was extended to create two football pitches when part of the adjacent field was rented from the Carver family.

At that time there was not as much pressure on the field and minimal conflict between the cricket and football interests. Since then, the playing surfaces have not changed but the increased use of the field throughout the year, combined with the playing success of 'the Coalies' (aka North Cave Coal Exporters Cricket Club) and their hard work to revitalise the cricket square, has brought into focus the conflict between the cricket square and the nearest football pitch.

With this in mind, the decision has been made to carry out some groundwork to extend the football playing surface further south towards the Everthorpe Lane side of the field. At the same time, it is planned to create a swale along the southern boundary (similar in character to the one along the car park boundary) to help catch runoff from the field heading towards Everthorpe Lane. This will help generate material to adjust the levels along this boundary to enlarge the playable surface for the football pitches. Once all this has had time to settle down and grow a good grass cover, it will be possible to re-mark out the pitches and move them further away from the cricket square and reduce the issues of the square being damaged by football spectators.



The recent safety inspection has highlighted the fact that the existing play area is very fast reaching the end of its life. We have had to take unsafe items out - sadly leaving gaps. It is becoming urgent that we raise the necessary funds to allow us to have a new play area in place before next summer.

We have been successful in receiving confirmation of funding from the S106 Commuted Sums - due as a result of the new development on Fountains Way. This, combined with other funding grants, fund raising activities such as the Bingo (grateful thanks to Jill and her hard-working team) and the generous donations on the LocalGiving page to date, means that we are well over half way in our efforts to raise funds needed but need more!

Funding bodies now ask that we show that we have other sources of funding to cover at least 10% of what they are giving to us. This is complicated because we have to make sure that we don't use the same money twice. So far we are managing to meet this demand but having donations, from individuals and companies that do not require this condition, makes it easier for us to meet this requirement.

We continue to fill in applications but we need people and companies to help. Everything donated, either directly to the NCPFA or through the LocalGiving page will help.

We would like to thank those who have already given and those who are donating a small amount regularly. It all helps! The more we get the closer we are to being able to hit the **GO Button**!

# North Cave Coal Exporters Cricket Club

It's been an enjoyable and interesting season for our first XI, the team ending the season placed 3rd in Holderness Division 1.

This should put the team in line for promotion, which is a really exciting development and will see the team competing in the Championship next season.

After a tricky run of results through July and the first half of August, the last two weeks saw the Coalies firsts' form return with strong batting performances from James Barker and James Forrester in particular and electric bowling from James Rounding!

August Bank Holiday Monday brought a great finale to the second XI's 2025 league campaign, with a well deserved win over Kirkella, at Church Street. The 37 runs victory cemented a third place finish in Division 3 Holderness for the Seconds, which unfortunately due to a change to league rules does not see the team secure promotion.

The final and eighth league win of the season brought up almost 350 league runs for James Morris, and saw Paul Gale and Dan Kemp hit over 200 league runs. Both Raj Roy and Andy Reeves finished with 19 league wickets, including a career best return for Reevesy of 8 for 42 against Middleton & North Dalton in May. Andy Swallow took 13 dismissals behind the stumps, and two juniors, Austin Bailey and Andrew Flockhart, made their senior debuts for the Coalies, with Andrew claiming his first senior wicket against eventual league champions Zingari.

Other highlights towards the end of the season included a hugely successful Under 9s Junior Festival on 17th August, which was brilliantly

supported and saw more than 60 youngsters from around East Yorkshire enjoy softball cricket at the



Playing Fields. Huge thanks to the NCCE members, Trust volunteers and everyone in the community who helped make the day such a success.
